#### PMM CERTIFICATION

Have you ever wondered how you measure up in the Mapping field? Are you a **good** Mapper or a **great** Mapper?

It is "that time of year" for anyone who is interested in taking the PMM exam to review their Mapping Course 600 &/or 601 books and to practice their inking skills!

To qualify to take the seven-hour PMM exam, you must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Have five full years of cadastral mapping experience or it's equivalent.
- 2. Be engaged in the use, production or maintenance of maps.
- 3. Attend a minimum of 30 hours of study in mapping, surveying or a closely related subject (i.e. IAAO Mapping Course 600 or 601.)
- 4. Fill out the application and drop it and the \$25 fee in the mail before March 15, 2008. (If you do not qualify to take the exam your \$25 will be returned.)

Your application will be reviewed by the Certification Committee to verify that you are a member in good standing of the Missouri Mappers Association and that you meet the qualifications to take the exam. The exam will be given in late March or early April at a time and location that is convenient for the applicants.
