Now for an update on other important items:


- ✓ Our MMA President, Frank Adam, is home now in Rolla recovering from his recent surgery. We all continue to wish him well.







Jeff Davis administered the PMM Certification test in Boone County on April 11. Successful applicants will be notified at the Annual Conference during the business meeting on Friday morning.


PMM (Professional Missouri Mapper) designation information will be available at the annual meeting for those who are interested. To qualify you must meet the following requirements:

Workshop #1:

"GPS Geocache Event"

8:30 am—11:30 am

Jay Riester \$ Scott Smith, Seiler Instrument

Seiler Instrument invites you to participate in a Geocache event. A Geocache is a "treasure hunt" using GPS equipment. It combines navigation with GPS to find hidden items and answering trivia questions at various points along the course. Learn how to use GPS for navigation, meet new people, and have fun. GPS equipment will be provided. Learn about proper GPS data collection Techniques.

Workshop #2:

"Introduction to ArcGIS"

8:30 am-11:30 am

Josie Bock, GISP \$ Andrea Bohn, Great River GIS

This introductory GIS workshop will cover a basic overview of what ArcGIS is and how it works. Topics include data formats, adding and symbolizing data, creating and exporting data layers, and creating a map. This workshop is intended for the beginning and soon-to-be GIS user. There are only 12 computers, so class is limited to registrations from 12 different organizations. This means that people from the same organization may have to share the same computer.

"Mobile GIS: Using GPS for GIS Data Collection and Maintenance"

This half-day workshop will cover the essentials of Mobile GIS. Mobile GIS is the process of moving GIS data into the field for data capture and update. A variety of hardware and software solutions are available for Mobile GIS. This presentation will highlight these solutions and associated applications. Topics will include: Understanding the Global Positioning System, applications for Mobile GIS, current hardware solutions, customizing data collection, updating GIS data in the field, and seamless data flow between GPS and GIS. This workshop will include a complete field-to-GIS data collection project using submeter and subfoot devices. Trimble mapping-grade GPS equipment will be provided so all students will get hands-on experience in the field.

"Draw the Line: Interpretation of Deeds and Land Descriptions for Mapping"

Donald Martin, Professional Surveyor, Jefferson City, Missouri

Draw the Line is a workshop addressing challenges that accompany the interpretation of legal records for mapping and spatial representation. Topics in this seminar include review of deed types, orders of precedence of calls, and how to deal with unique situations in reading and plotting "legals". Land descriptions are the record representation of title in property and their spatial representation is a critical endeavor. This workshop will add to mappers' skill-sets in the important role they have as graphic scriveners of important records.

Registration deadline is **July 13, 2009**. A late fee of \$25.00 each will be applied to all registrations received after that date, and no registration fees will be refunded after that date.


Alcohol Policy




