## LightSquared GPS Fight Continues Reprinted From May 2011 ACSM Government Affairs Update

ACSM is continuing to fight for the integrity of nationwide GPS as LightSquared (a private company that recently received a waiver from the FCC to develop its 4G wireless network next to the GPS spectrum) continues to move forward with its planned activities, which could disrupt GPS usage throughout the country.

Curt Sumner, Laurence Socci and David Holland met recently with staff from the offices of Senator Mark Warner (D-VA) and Senator Jim Webb (D-VA) as well as Representative Eric Cantor (R-VA) to discuss the effect the FCC waiver for Light-Squared will have on the surveying community nationwide. It was clear from the meetings with staff of Senators Warner and Webb that they are on LightSquared's side of the issue and went so far as to suggest that GPS users should upgrade their GPS units to make them work alongside LightSquared's proposed network.

The meeting with staff of Majority Leader Eric Cantor went better than the meeting with the Senate staff. Cantor's staff person understood the issue and was sympathetic to our concerns. Laurence Socci and Curt Sumner will meet soon with Marty Dannenfelser, Senior Policy Advisor for the House Committee on Energy and Commerce. The Energy and Commerce Committee has jurisdiction over the LightSquared GPS issue. We are hoping to have a hearing on the issue and to have an ACSM representative testify at that hearing.

A report on the effects of LightSquared's proposed network on nationwide GPS is due to the FCC on June 15. In the meantime, continue to write to your Members of Congress and voice your concern regarding this issue. For more information on this issue, go to http://www.saveourgps.org

## Legislative Committee Report

The legislation that passed this year that is of real concern for the Missouri Mappers Association was about the Assessor's Reimbursement Funding. Originally the Governor proposed \$4.00 per parcel reimbursement and the final funding amount is \$3.41 per parcel based on the 2009 parcel count.

Funding of the Assessor's Offices will have an impact not only on assessment work but on the ability of Assessors and their employees to attend training and conferences such as the Missouri Mappers Association Conference this July. For the next budget year, all members of the Missouri Mappers Association need to contact their State Legislators and Senators and inform them of the importance of proper funding of the Assessor's Offices and about the work Assessor's Offices do.

In past legislation, Senate Bill 384, Cadastral Standards Bill was passed in 2009. Apparently funding for the Missouri State Land Surveyor to implement standards has been appropriated. A meeting of various groups with interest in this matter is going to be held on July 14, 2011, in Jefferson City, at the Missouri Department of Conservation Credit Union. The following is part of an email I received from Mr. Tim Haithcoat, State Geographical Informational Officer:

#### Invitation to Participate

Missouri Cadastral Mapping Standards Working Group

#### The why:

The Missouri Cadastral Mapping Standard is intended to support the development, automation, integration and sharing of publicly available land records information. It is intended to be useable by all levels of government and the private sector. The standard contains the standardization of entities and objects related to cadastral map-based information including survey measurements, general property description, and recompilation of parcel sources. Any or all of these cadastral applications are intended to be supported by the standard. The standard is not intended to reflect an implementation design. An implementation design requires adapting the structure and form of these definitions to meet application requirements.

#### The what:

The Missouri Cadastral Mapping Standards Working Group will also adapt the FGDC Cadastral Data Content Standard Mission Statement as follows:

To provide a standard for the definition, structure, and digital representation of cadastral data which will facilitate data sharing at all levels of government and the private sector and will protect and enhance the investments in cadastral data at all levels of government and the private sector.

#### The how:

In July the State is going to form a cadastral mapping working group. As the cadastral mapping standard develops, through a series of meetings, draft versions will be circulated to a broader stakeholder group as well as working group participants / liaisons.

At a to be planned Late-Summer/Early-Fall 2011 Cadastral Mapping Standards Forum, representatives from federal, state, local, private and academic sectors will provide a final review of the Missouri Cadastral Mapping Standard. The results of this review will be incorporated into the standard.

#### The when:

On July 14, 2011 from 1:00 – 3:00 at the Missouri Conservation Credit Union meeting room, the kick-off meeting for the Cadastral Mapping Standards will be held. Map to MDC. \*\*\*

Participate by teleconference: call 1-866-910-4857 and join meeting 449856. Press \*6 during the call to mute/unmute your line. Please do not use your phone's Hold function as this can introduce music or periodic beeping onto the teleconference.

At this meeting the goal of the group will be communicated, the rules making process will be reviewed, the draft surveyor standard will be distributed and initially discussed, and the schedule / timeline with milestones will be determined for this activity.

Proposed Minimum Standards dated of 4-18-2011 have been emailed to some people, who all received them I do not know. Since I received the email with the information about the meeting, other groups have started requesting to be included. Will other group(s) not mentioned above be allowed to attend? I do not know. It should be an interesting meeting and one that MMA desperately needs to have a representative(s) attend.

Barbara reported for Carla they hope to be able to show pictures on computer at conference. She has made several copies to put in different areas.




- Katie let us know that Ryon would be able to change anything on the website if need be in pretty short notice.


