JANUARY 1995

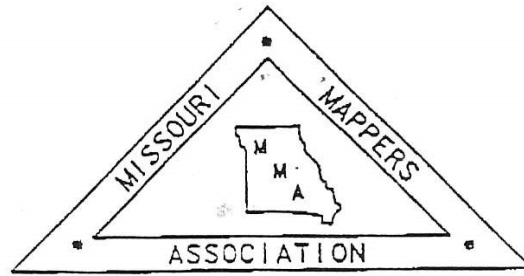
Thirty people met in October at Viburnum, Missouri for a tour of the Doe Run Mine.

PMM CERTIFICATION EXAMINATION

The Missouri Mappers Association PMM certification examination will be scheduled for sometime in April or May of 1995. If you meet the following designation requirements, you are eligible to take the 7 hour comprehensive and subjective examination:

1. Have five full years of cadastral mapping experience or its equivalent.
2. Be engaged in the use, production, or maintenance of cadastral maps.
3. Attended a minimum of 30 hours of study in mapping, surveying or a closely related subject.

In order to be scheduled for the examination, you must complete a certification application and submit information verifying that you meet the requirements listed above. This information must be received by the certification committee no later than March 15, 1995. A \$25.00 Fee is also required.

of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of

One Dollar and further consideration hereinafter expressed,

DOLLARS

to them paid by the said part of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents Grant, Bargain

and Sell, Convey and Confirm, unto the said part of the second part, the following described tract of land, situated in the

County of Franklin and State of Missouri, to-wit: The East 1/2 of the South West 1/4 of section 32, the North West 1/4 of the South West 1/4

of section 32, containing in the aggregate 1600 acres, more or less in Township 43 North

Range 1 West of the 5th P. M. opening roadway sold to Lewis Wilmeaker by deed of

record in Volume 92 at page 423, like the roadway conveyed to Matthias Sherkholz by

deed of Wilmeaker, by deed in Vol. 92 at page 423

do and for a further consideration the said parties of the second part, agree to and bind

himself to pay the sum of \$100.00 yearly, in cash, to the said parties of the first part,

for and during the term of their natural life, and to pay the taxes on the property

hereby conveyed.

The said parties of the second part, as a further consideration, agree to furnish the said parties of the first part,

for and during their natural life, yearly, with 300 pounds of flour, 100 lbs weighing about 200 pounds, 1/2 acre of

garden space, and sufficient of butter, eggs, milk, chickens, and fire wood for their comfort and subsistence.

The said parties of the first part reserve the right to live on the above described premises for and

during their natural life.

All parties hereto further agree that if the said Matthias Sherkholz shall survive the said Margaret Sherkholz, the said parties of the second part shall pay to the said Matthias Sherkholz, the sum of \$100.00 annually for and during his natural life, but should the said Margaret Sherkholz survive the said Matthias Sherkholz, the said parties of the second part shall pay to the said Margaret Sherkholz, the sum of \$50.00 for and during her natural life.

If there is a high school in your area, contact them and advise them of this opportunity for a senior interested in the surveying profession.

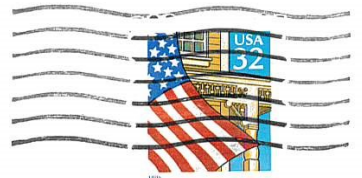
