For members who use GIS, would like to learn more about GIS, or those of you who actually have money in your budgets this year for conferences and training, the 8th Annual Missouri GIS Conference will be held March 24-25, 2003, at the Holiday Inn Select Executive Center in Columbia, MO. I hope all MMA members will be able to attend. The conference will have 5 full-day and 2 half-day shortcourses. The topics for full-day shortcourses are ESRI geodatabase, Intro to Arc GIS, Advanced Arc View 3.3, Auto Desk Workshop and Addressing. Two half-day workshops will be Remote Sensing/DOQs and Mobile Computing. I encourage everyone to sign up for these courses. The courses which teach ESRI software will be conducted by authorized ESRI instructors. The downside of these courses is that you will not receive a certificate from ESRI for your training. The upside of the training is that the cost for the training has been significantly reduced, and the University of Missouri will offer CEU's for the workshops at an additional cost of \$5.00.

WARREN COUNTY GETS NEW ASSESSOR

On January 7, 2003, Allen W. Dreyer was sworn in as the new Warren County Assessor. He was appointed by Governor Holden after Mike Sutherland resigned to take on his new position as Representative in the Missouri House. Dreyer will hold the office until the outcome of the November 2004 election.

Dreyer, a native of Warren County, graduated from Warren County R-3 High School in 1966, attended Northeast Missouri State University in Kirksville where he received his BSE with a major in Mathematics and a minor in Business in 1970. In March, 1974, he enlisted in the Army Security Agency and worked as a computer operator for three years (2-1/2 years were spent in Germany).

After his time in the Army, Dreyer started teaching high school mathematics at his alma mater. Following seven years of teaching and receiving a Master's degree from NMSU, he became assistant principal in the high school. Fifteen years later, after receiving his specialist degree, he was junior high principal, retiring in July, 2001.

Dreyer has been married to his wife, Barbara, for 21 years. They have two sons, Blake age 16 and Daniel age 12. All are active members of St. John's Lutheran Church where Dreyer is an Elder, usher & Sunday School Teacher. He is also an active member of the local Democratic Party.

Dreyer's hobbies include playing cards, traveling, watching movies and watching his sons play sports.

Dreyer's vision for the Assessor's office is to keep pace with our growing county. He sees a need to hire and train additional staff members. He also wants to upgrade the current computer software programs and keep moving forward with the GIS.




