
The Missouri Mappers Association would like to welcome Representative Mike Sutherland to the 22nd Annual Conference!







Workshop descriptions & presenter bios

"Geodatabase Basics" Anne Ewing, ESRI, Basic ArcGIS Experience Preferred

This workshop introduces basic elements of a geodatabase such as tables, annotation, feature classes, feature datasets and relationship classes. Participants will explore the geodatabase structure and properties in ArcCatalog, as well as geodatabase storage options and techniques to convert existing data into a geodatabase. This hands-on workshop is for those familiar with the ArcGIS 9.x applications (ArcView/ArcEditor/ArcInfo), those considering migrating or just getting started with the geodatabase data model.

Anne Ewing joined ESRI as a Technical Analyst in June 2000. She received a B.S. degree in Geography from Northwest Missouri State University and attended Southern Illinois University, where her primary studies included Geography and GIS. Anne is a member the Professional Services group at ESRI. Her focus is ArcGIS Desktop applications and ArcObjects programming. Her involvement with client training and consulting services has helped customers leverage ESRI products to meet their business needs. Anne recently became the Training Coordinator for the St. Louis regional office. In that role she will be managing the ESRI central region training program, as well as teaching several instructor-led training classes at ESRI's St. Charles, MO. training center.

"Lines, Tangents & Bearings....Oh My!: Understanding Legal Descriptions" Mark Kemper, The Sidwell Company, Instruments and Handouts will be Provided, Registrants Must Bring Calculators

Have you ever found yourself working on a legal description mumbling "There is no place like home, there is no place like home," while clicking your heels together? This workshop is for people who have a basic understanding of legal descriptions, and those working at an intermediate level that could use some practice. 

"Cadastral Mapping for Today's World" Workshop, Larry Bollinger, St. Louis County Highway Department, Registrants must bring a Pencil, Straight Edge, 6 Sheets of Plain White Paper (8 ½" x 11") and Calculator (Protractor, Compass and Triangles may be helpful, but are not essential)

Cadastral mapping requires the application of both historical property data and modern technology. This workshop will address practical considerations for better coordination between basic cadastral mapping techniques and updated techniques through advancing technology. Whichever world you feel most comfortable in, this workshop will touch on the many reasons that we need to incorporate common mapping techniques into new and innovative mapping methods. Building the enterprise cadastral map is a team effort that requiring the application of all these skills!

Larry Bollinger currently serves as the Survey Office Manager for the St. Louis County Highway Department, Construction Division, Survey Section. He has worked continuously in surveying and related fields for over 40 years and has been a licensed land surveyor since 1977. He has worked for the U.S. Army Construction Engineering Battalions in Korea and Germany; Elbring and Volz Engineering and Surveying Companies; and Bollinger Surveying Company where he was the sole proprietor for many years. He has also instructed land surveying and engineering courses at the St. Louis Community College. The Missouri Mappers Association presented Larry with the Education Award in 2004.

10:00 A.M. – 10:30 A.M. "Guidelines for Drafting a Digital Orthophotography RFP," Brian Baker, The Sidwell Company

Brian Baker has over seventeen years of aerial mapping experience and is currently a GIS and Photogrammetric Account Manager for The Sidwell Company. He has previously served as Project Manager, Production Manager and Orthophotography Department Manager with another Midwestern Photogrammetric Company. Brian earned his B.S. degree in Geography from Missouri State University and is a Certified Photogrammetrist.

In this session, Brian Baker provides professionals with the tools they need to successfully draft a Digital Orthophotography RFP. He will address the standard specifications for a digital orthophotography RFP as well as the goals for your digital photography. The session will also outline how to ask the right questions in your RFP and the various items that should be included.


10:50 A.M. – 11:20 A.M. "Utilizing Missouri State Tax Commission Mapping Guidelines for County GIS Development," Matt Sorensen, Midland GIS Solutions

Matt Sorensen is a Project Manager and Vice President of Midland GIS Solutions. Matt has over 12 years of experience in the management and technological dimensions of GIS, land records, and implementation solutions. He holds a B.S. degree in Geography from Northwest Missouri State University and has served as project manager for over 20 local government GIS projects in the Midwest. Matt is an active member of Missouri Mappers Association and the Urban and Regional Information Systems Association (URISA).

Although mapping techniques and technology are continuously changing, the relevance of the Missouri State Tax Commission Mapping Guidelines still apply today. Matt will address the use of these guidelines in GIS development to encourage accurate tax mapping and maintenance. This session will review the original intent of the State Tax Commission Guidelines and outline some general reasons why GIS programs may fail as a result of not following these mapping specifications.

11:40 A.M. – 12:10 P.M. "US Public Land Survey System," Mike Flowers, PLS, Missouri Department of Natural Resources

J. Michael Flowers is the State Land Surveyor and Land Survey Program Director within the Department of Natural Resources' Division of Geology and Land Survey. Mr. Flowers has been involved in land surveying and geodetic surveying for the past thirty-six years and licensed since 1978. He became the State Land Surveyor September 1, 1998. The Land Survey Program includes a Land Records Repository with over 1.8 million surveys. The program is responsible for the restoration and maintenance of the United States Public Land Survey System (USPLSS) corners in Missouri. The Program also executes geodetic surveys throughout the state and maintains a database for vertical and horizontal control. Mr. Flowers is the Past President of the Missouri Society of Professional Land Surveyors, Past President of the American Association of State Surveyors, and a member of the American Congress on Surveying and Mapping.



MAPPES ASSOCIATION OF MAPPES

The United States Public Land Survey System (USPLSS) is the basis for title to all real property in the State of Missouri. The first surveys made in the Missouri territory, subsequent to the Upper and Lower Louisiana Purchase by the U.S. in 1803 was the survey of the 5th Principal Meridian in 1815 by P.K. Robbins. Between 1815 and 1855, all of Missouri was surveyed by the General Land Office (GLO). Today the land corners, field notes and plats are preserved by the State's land survey office in Rolla. This presentation will give a brief history of the USPLSS in Missouri and show some of the normal and unusual divisions of lands that are the basis for parcel maps used and developed by Missouri Mappers.

1:30 P.M. - 2:00 P.M. "Public Access to GIS Data," Sarah Murray, Schneider Corporation

Sarah Murray is involved in Business Development for the Schneider Corporation. With advancing technology and the need for up-to-date and accurate information, many organizations are providing public access to GIS data. This session will discuss how and why organizations are making their GIS data available to the public.





Mark Allen is the GIS/Data Controller for the City of Higginsville. Mark currently collects and maintains the city's GIS data which includes Electric, Water, Sewer, Storm Sewer and Street Maintenance Data. Mark worked for Bendix Corporation in Kansas City, MO from 1983 to 1994 where he assisted with inhouse GIS for facility management. Prior to working for the City of Higginsville, Mark created and maintained a GIS for the City of Odessa's Electrical Utilities where he also worked in a power plant and installed and maintained electrical lines.

Utilizing a GIS for city infrastructure mapping and maintenance can be beneficial for any city department. In this session, Mark will discuss the importance of utility mapping and how to accurately maintain data.
