





# WEDNESDAY WORKSHOPS

#### **MORNING - 8:30 - 11:30**

#### ArcGIS Advanced Topics, Tips, and Tricks - Josie Bock, ClearBasin Software

This half day workshop will demonstrate various techniques such as advanced queries, editing, and analysis using the ArcGIS 10.3.1/10.4 software environment. We will also be going over tips and tricks that will hopefully help make your ArcGIS work easier.

Josie Bock, GISP, is currently the GIS Director for ClearBasin Software, LLC located in Springfield, MO. ClearBasin Software serves the county government tax and administration software market with web-enabled GIS solutions. With over 20 years of GIS experience in the industry, Josie is always happy to share her knowledge and support with those wanting to learn.

Riparian Rights and Other Challenging Parcel Mapping Issues - Matt Sorensen, Midland GIS Solutions
This workshop will focus on mapping parcels along water boundaries, (e.g. rivers, lakes, and creeks). The State of Missouri has thousands of miles of river and lake shoreline. Mapping parcels along these water boundaries can sometimes be confusing and overwhelming. We will discuss riparian rights and how some of these water boundary mapping issues have been handled in various counties throughout the State. We will also take time to work "hands-on" on a few challenging water boundary mapping examples, the old fashioned way, on hardcopy example maps. If you can map it the old fashioned way, you can easily map it into your GIS. Engineering scales, protractors, and example maps, with corresponding deeds, will be provided as part of this workshop.

Matt Sorensen is the Sr. Vice President of Midland GIS Solutions. Matt has worked at Midland GIS since its inception in 2000, and has worked with over 50 counties with their parcel mapping GIS development. Matt obtained his Bachelors in Geography from Northwest Missouri State University in 1994, and has been a member of MMA for 14 years.

# THURSDAY PRESENTATIONS

#### **Keynote Speaker** (9:00-9:45)

Michael Groose, Former Missouri State Penitentiary Warden 1990-1995

Michael began his work with corrections in 1968, and retired with 32 years of service. He spent the majority of that time managing some facet of a correctional facility. He was in charge of custody of a 1,000 bed medium security facility in the 1980's. In 1990, he became the Warden of the Missouri State Penitentiary. He was promoted to a Deputy Director of Adult Prisons in 1995. In 2001, he was promoted to Director of Human Services for the Department of Corrections. This placed him in charge of the training of all correctional staff in the State, and all personnel functions. He has testified in the United States Federal Courts extensively in cases involving the Department of Corrections, conditions of confinement, policy and procedures, inmate treatment, etc. He has been accepted as an "Expert Witness" in the Federal Courts to testify in correctional cases before the court. From 1990-1999, he was a Professor at Columbia College teaching undergraduate and graduate level criminal justice and management classes in the evening program. Michael retired in 2002.

#### The Role of The Missouri State Tax Commission (9:45-10:30)

Maureen Monaghan, Chief Counsel, State Tax Commission

This presentation will cover how the State Tax Commission and the Assessor's Offices are connected.

Maureen provides legal counsel for the three member Commission, presides over appeals submitted to the STC, manages the appraisal of railroad, pipeline, and utility properties, and provides information to Assessors, Collectors, and other County officials as well as the public in general. Maureen has served the STC since 2007. Prior to that, she was an Assistant Prosecuting Attorney for Cole County, Missouri. In that role, she not only handled prosecution of major felonies, but also served as counsel for county officials, and as the Juvenile Officer. Maureen graduated from the University of Missouri-Columbia Law School in 1989, after graduating from their School of Business in 1986. She currently resides in Jefferson City, Missouri with her husband Dave, and pets - Sammy Sosa the cat and Ernie Banks the dog. (Although the family pledges their allegiance to the St. Louis Cardinals, her son, rebelling, became a Cubs fan and named all the pets after Cubs players.) She has two children - Jane and Matt - who have graduated and are currently off the payroll.

#### Introduction to the NFIP and FEMA RiskMAP Program (10:45-11:30)

L. Scott Samuels, SEMA Floodplain Management Engineer

This presentation will layout the basic NFIP requirements for community participation and the mapping products produced to support their membership, including the evolution of the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) product that is the basis for governing development in the regulatory floodplains.

Mr. Samuels has been active in the world of floodplain management since 1998. He has worked for the State of Missouri Emergency Management Agency (SEMA) as their Floodplain Management Engineer for over 7 years. He also operated a sole proprietorship consulting firm specializing in floodplain management issues for 11 years. He is active with the Missouri Floodplain and Stormwater Managers Associations (MfSMA) having served as an Area Director, Membership Secretary, and Chair of the Legislative Committee (not all at the same time). He earned a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from Colorado State University, at Fort Collins, CO in 1988, and is a Registered Professional Engineer in Missouri, Maine, Ohio, and West Virginia.

#### Field Data Collection Using ArcGIS Online (11:30-12:15)

Alexis M Gieseker, GIS Specialist, State of Missouri

Survey 123, Collector, and GeoForm oh my! This session will cover the differences and various ways to collect data utilizing the ArcGIS Online platform. We will conduct a hands on exercise so, BYOD - Bring Your Own Device.

Mrs. Gieseker has worked for the State of Missouri as a Geographical Information Systems Specialist for over 12 years. She earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Geography with an emphasis in Geographical Information Systems from University of Missouri, at Columbia, MO in 2005 and is a certified Geographical Information System (GIS) Professional, GISP.

#### Deeds and Chain of Title Q & A (1:30-2:30)

David Townsend, Agents National Title Insurance Company

Our most requested speaker is back again this year! This session will be a full hour devoted to answering your most perplexing deed and real estate title questions.

David A. Townsend is President and CEO of Agents National Title Insurance Company, a regional title insurance underwriter based in Columbia, Missouri. Agents National Title Insurance was founded to meet the needs of independent title agents. Mr. Townsend is a graduate of the University of Missouri School of Law, and Drury University, and has many years of experience in the areas of real estate and title law. Mr. Townsend is a speaker for the American Land Title Association, Missouri Land Title Association Title School, October Research Seminars, and other continuing education seminars. He is a member of the American Bar Association, the Missouri Bar Association, and the Missouri Department of Insurance Title Insurance Advisory Committee, Missouri Land Title Association, Indiana Land Title Association, Arkansas Land Title Association, Kansas Land Title Association, and the US Attorney's Mortgage Fraud Task Force for the Eastern District of Missouri. Mr. Townsend is the author of the Missouri Bar Insurance Practice Series: Title Insurance and the Missouri Bar Journal article Mechanics Lien Law: Section 429.016 establishes new notice requirements. Named the Missouri Land Title Young Title Professional for 2009, David was awarded the National Title Professional designation in 2013 by the American Land Title Association. David is married to Kerry Townsend, has one daughter, Blair and one son, Charlie, and lives in Columbia, Missouri.

#### **Applied GIS for Economic Development (2:30-3:15)**

Curtis Copeland, GIS Coordinator, City of Branson

The City of Branson is currently undergoing a couple of major redevelopment and revitalization projects. The City has utilized a number of GIS applications, modeling, and analysis for project planning, decision making, and project tracking. This presentation will review some of those processes and models, and the tools used to create them.

Curtis is in his 18th year as the City of Branson GIS Coordinator. He really enjoys his career, and truly believes that GIS technology can be used to improve not only local government, but business, environment, healthcare....anything geographically related....which is almost everything! Curtis grew up in Springfield and Branson, attended Kickapoo High School, and graduated from MSU in 1997 with a degree in Geospatial Science.

#### A Picture is Worth a Thousand Words (3:30-4:15)

Chet Hunter, Emergency Management Director, Greene County Missouri

This presentation will show how mapping definitely impacts many areas, especially Emergency Management. We currently use mapping to guide our decision making, understand impact, and capture recovery.

Chet Hunter was appointed Director of the Springfield-Greene County, Office of Emergency Management (OEM) in the summer of 2014. He is responsible for overall management of the Office of Emergency Management. He supervises all command staff personnel and maintains an ongoing capability to activate and support the Emergency Operations Center (EOC). Mr. Hunter has over 19 years of combined public safety experience. He has been part of the fire service (5 years), emergency medical services (13 years), 911 communications (3 years), and the emergency management field (8 years). Mr. Hunter received a Bachelor's Degree in Intercultural and Diversity Studies from Baptist Bible College, as well as Missouri Certified Emergency Manager through Missouri Emergency Managers Association (MOEMA), a licensed Emergency Medical Technician, and holds the Professional Development Series and Advanced Professional Development Series Certificates from FEMA. He also received a Masters Infrastructure Protection Certificate from Texas A&M Engineering Extension. Mr. Hunter is active in the Southwest Missouri Emergency Service Organization and is a member of the Southwest Missouri Incident Support Team (IST) as Logistics Section Chief. He also supports the Greene County Community Organization Active in Disasters as co-chair. In addition, he serves as President for the Missouri Emergency Management Association. Chet and his wife Cortney of 10 years have three children, and reside in the Greene County area.




